'RUN FOR UNITY'



Rashtriya Ekta Diwas is celebrated every year on 31st October to commemorate the Birth Anniversary of **Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel**, India's first Home Minister and one of the founding fathers of India who was solely responsible for the unification of Modern India. This year marks the 147th birth anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel. On the occasion a **Unity Run** was organized by the Directorate of Education in which schools across Delhi participated enthusiastically. A total of **117** students from **Gyan Bharati School, Saket** actively participated in the run, which was conducted in three phases.
