Visit to the Kiran Nadar Museum of Art, Saket

- Women and their various shades- (Painting of a Bangladeshi actress against a Vietnamese woman warrior holding a child by Main Ijaz ul Hassan.
- Cartoon Art by Chitra Durga
- Break the usual norm for Art by C.K Rajan
- Art focusing on Modernization and Urbanization (showcasing compact and congested lives of people) by Bhupen Khakhar.

After the museum walk and exploring the exhibits, there was an interactive session with the Director Mrs. Rubina, wherein the teachers got an opportunity to share their experience and observations.
