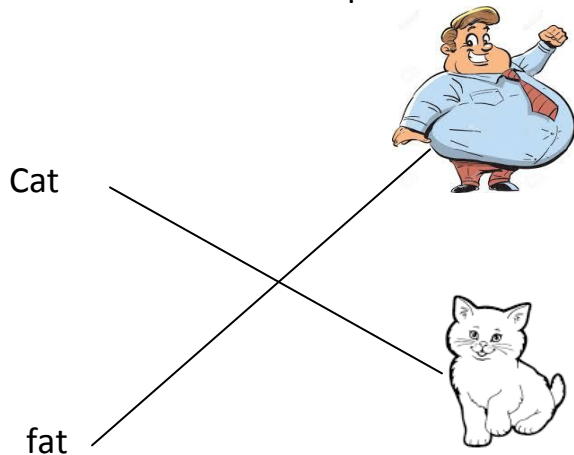


CURRICULUM INPUTS OF KG

ENGLISH

- ❖ Reads fluently words with vowel 'a', 'i' and 'o'. E.g. - can, map, lad, jam, wag, bin, bib, rim, dog, God, mop etc. and understands their meanings
- ❖ Matches words to their picture correctly-



- ❖ Reads simple words from newspaper/books etc.
- ❖ Reads simple sentences fluently and illustrates their meanings clearly.

E.g. -

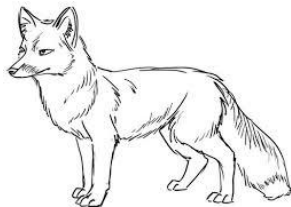
A rat is on a mat.

- ❖ Cuts and pastes the correct letter in the blank to make a meaningful word.

pin

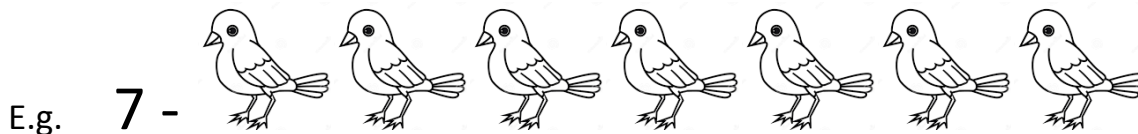
- ❖ Plays chain game of words.
E.g. cat- tap- pan-nap-pin....
- ❖ Identifies the rhyming words to a given word.

E.g. bag-rag, fin-bin, hut-nut

- ❖ Guesses the word correctly when its meaning is dramatized.

NUMBER CONCEPT

- ❖ Recognizes numbers from 3 to 14 and associates them with objects correctly.



- ❖ Understands the concept of what comes after/ before the given number.

E.g. _____ , 10
7 , _____

- ❖ Fills in the missing numbers correctly with number cards(1-14)

E.g. 4, __, __, 7, __, __, 10

- ❖ Identifies the biggest/ smallest numbers from the given numbers (1-14)

E.g.

7 **12** 10 – **12** is the biggest number.

3 14 6 – **3** is the smallest number.

- ❖ Recites number rhymes with rhythmic movement.

E.g. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 once I caught a fish alive...

One two buckle my shoe....

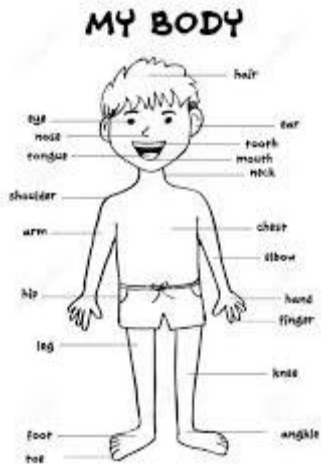

My Body

- ❖ Learns the names of different parts of our body and appreciates their functions.

E.g. arm, elbow, wrist, hips, knee etc.



My Family

- ❖ Talks about his/her family, number of members, their likes/dislikes etc.



My House

- ❖ Identifies the various rooms in a house, things that belong to a particular room, the home address etc.



My School

- ❖ Goes for a walk in the school premise to explore it.



Summer Season

- ❖ Observes the changes in the environment during 'summer season', e.g. long days and short nights, hot dry winds etc.
- ❖ Talks about the things they like to eat/drink e.g. – cold lassi, ice-cream, curd and clothes they prefer to wear.



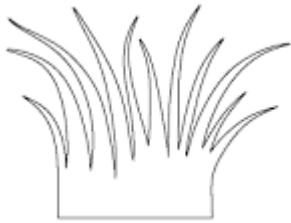
Rainy Season

- ❖ Observes the changes in the environment- overcast sky, thunder, lightening, puddles of water etc.
- ❖ Identifies things used in rainy season. E.g. umbrella, raincoat, gumboots etc.
- ❖ Talks why she likes/dislikes this season.



Plant Life

- ❖ Goes for a nature walk and identifies the types of plants.

plant-grass

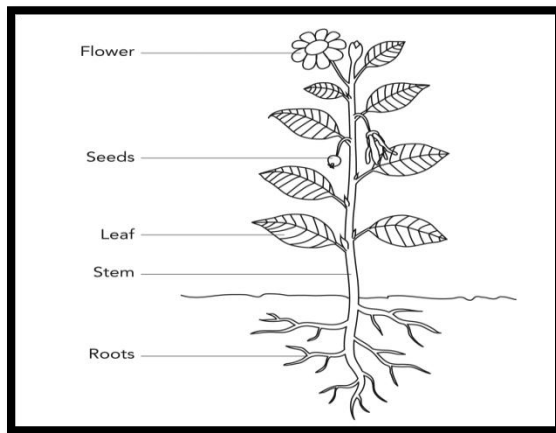


small plants-
bushes



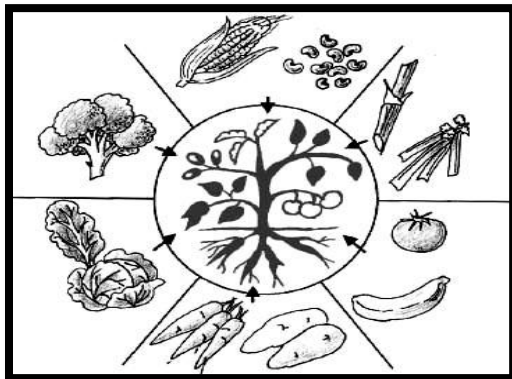
big plants-

- ❖ Names the shady trees in school and around the houses. E.g. Neem, peepal, jamun.
- ❖ Identifies parts of the plant. E.g. roots, trunk, branches, leaves, bud, flower, fruits and understands their functions.

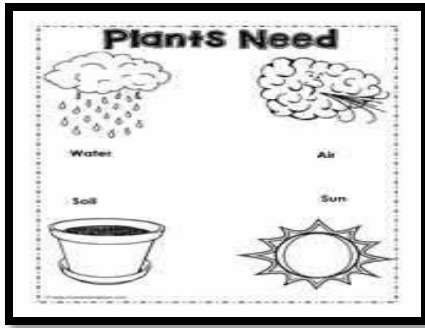


Parts of a plant

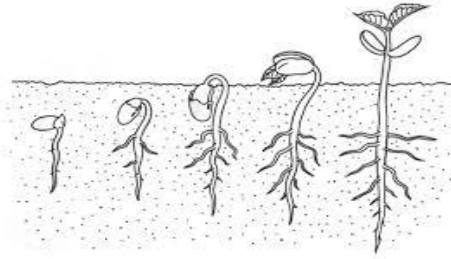
- ❖ Understands the importance of planting trees for life on earth and discusses about different things we get from plants. E.g. wood, fruits, vegetables, cotton, medicines and oxygen.



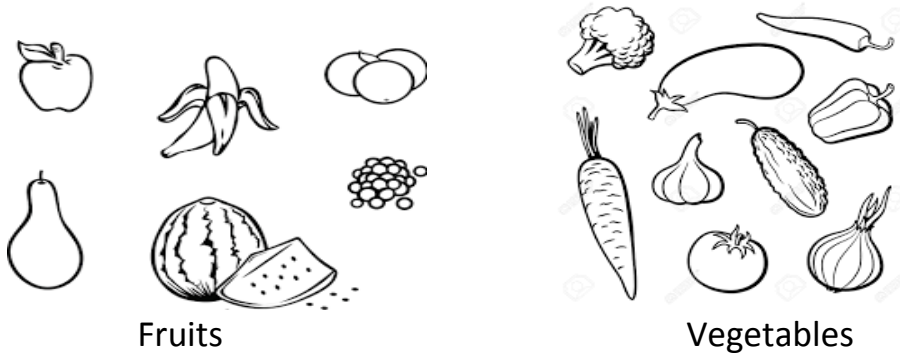
- ❖ Learns about different conditions that are necessary for a plant to grow. E.g. sun, water and air.



- ❖ Observes germination of seed and records the changes in the seed.



- ❖ Identifies the various fruits and vegetables and learns their English/ Hindi names. Classifies them according to their number of seeds, season, colour and taste.



Animal Life

- ❖ Classifies animals into pet/ domestic/ wild. Talks about their physical features, eating habits, habitat etc. using picture cards, books, power point presentation etc.
