- Gets familiar with the concept of taking continuous uniform jumps to achieve different number patterns .(Skip counting)

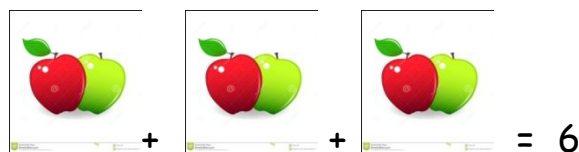
For eg. 2,4 ,6 ,8 ,10,12 ,-----

- Writes skip counting by 2,3,4,5,10

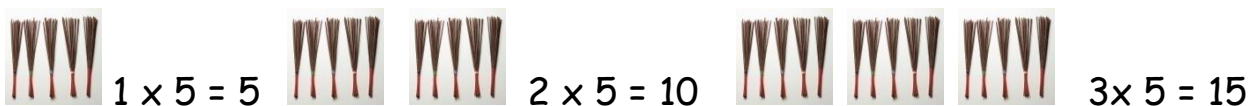
November - December

- Understands measurements with units.



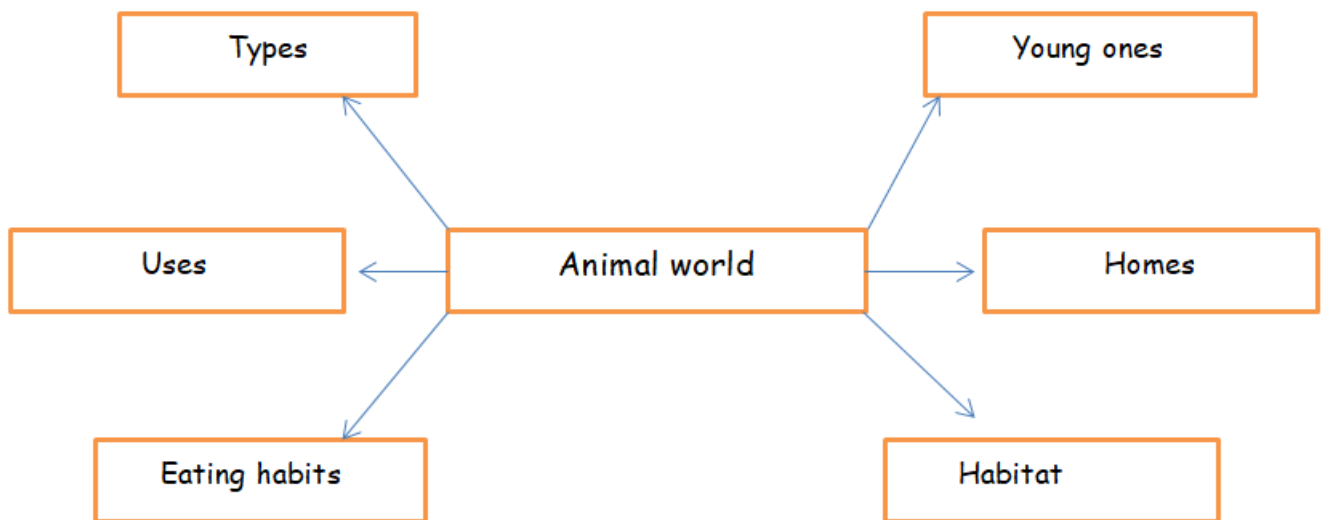
- Gets familiar with the concept of units for non-standard measurement.

- Does mental math activities.

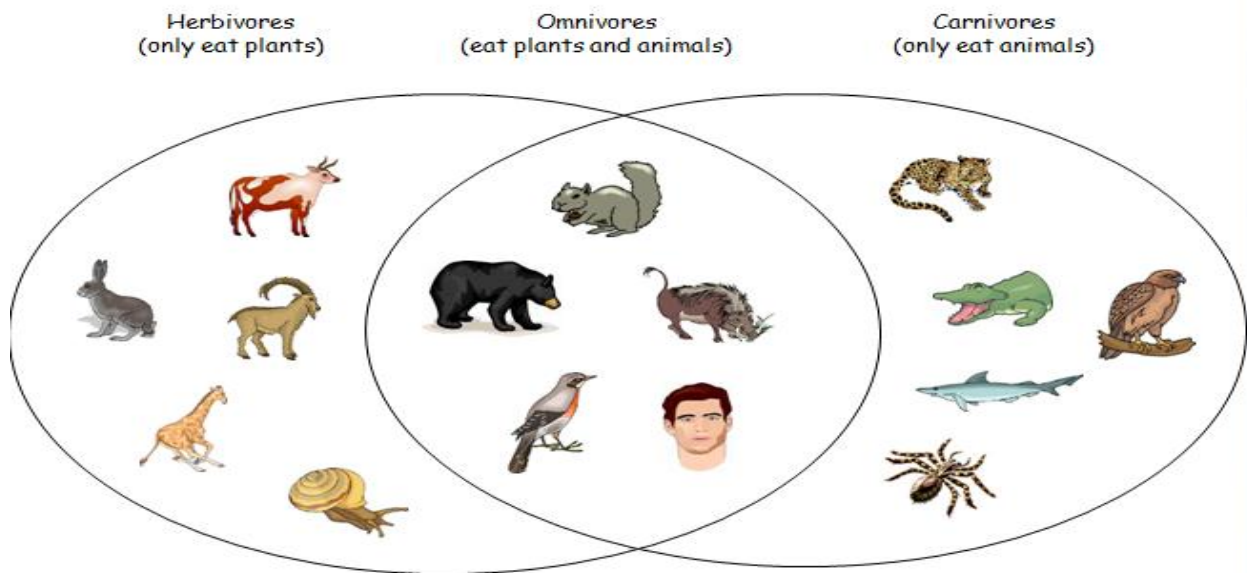

Theme: Animal Life



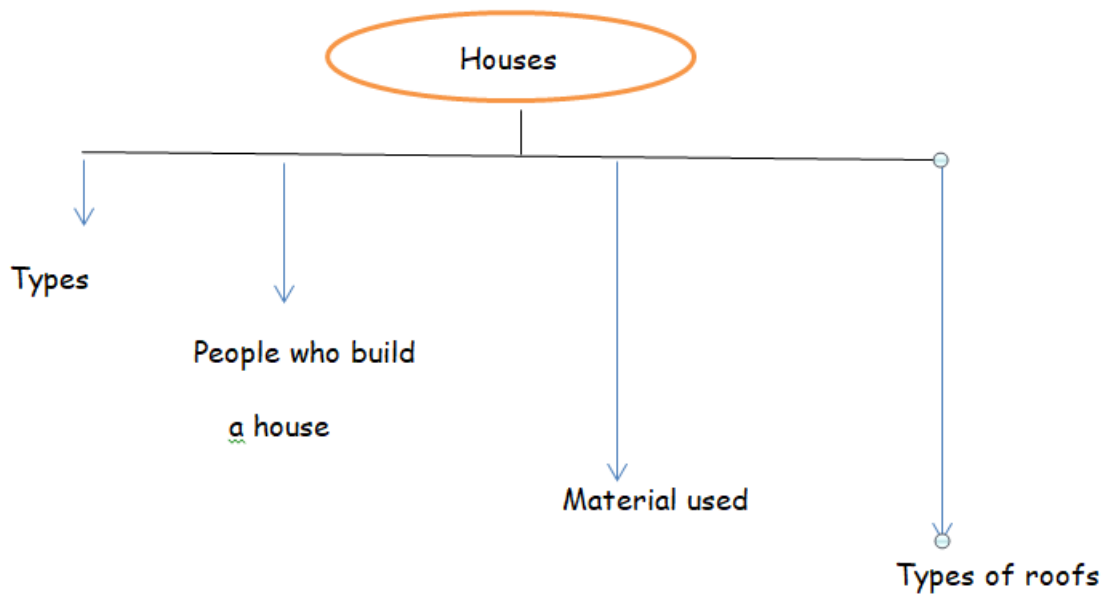
- Observes and talks about animals- their young ones, homes and sounds

NOVEMBER

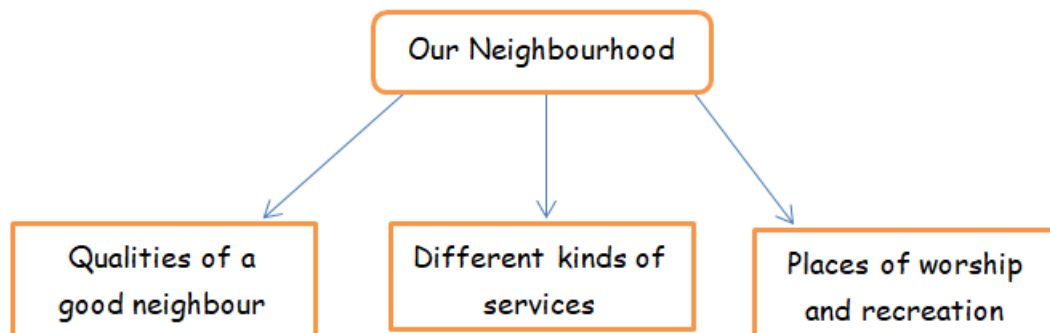
Theme: Houses



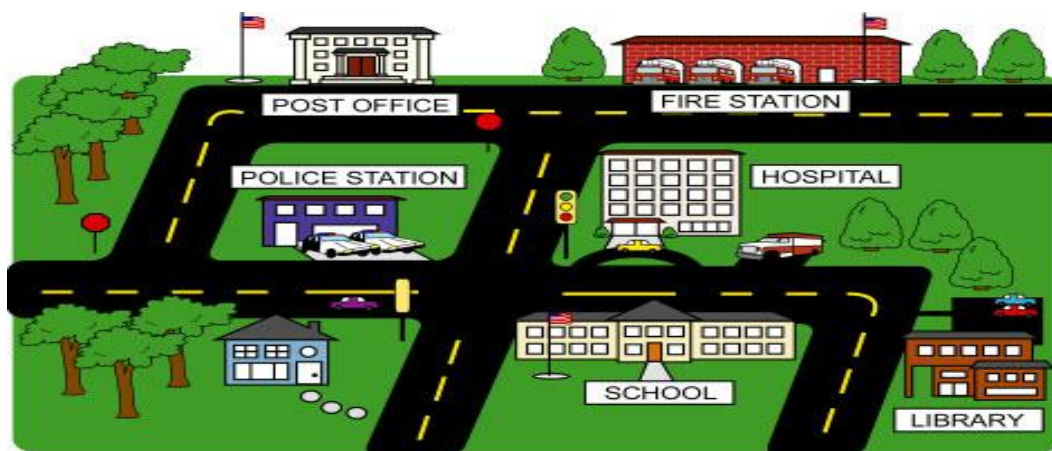
- Understands the need for houses.

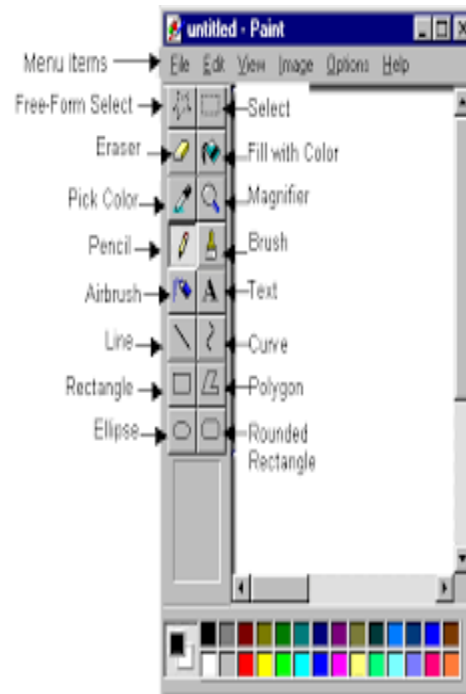
