





SUGGESTED ACTIVITIES

1) PREPOSITION-ACTION DICE GAME

Using cardboard/slam sheet make two cubes which will act as dice in this new preposition game. Write a preposition on each face of the first cube like in between, in front, under, etc.

Now, write an action on each face of the second cube like eat, sleep, study etc.

You can play it in pairs or with more members of the family. Roll both the dice together. Join the combination of the preposition and the action together and make a sentence using both of them. For example, "for + study" could result in "I have been studying English for two years." Try to form grammatically correct sentences.

2) CONJUNCTION STRIP ACTIVITY

This game will be played in pairs. Each player will write a simple sentence. Cut some strips of paper and write random conjunctions on each of them like and, but, so, or etc.


