ENGLISH

- ❖ Reads words with vowel 'e' fluently, understands their meanings and illustrates them clearly.
e.g. - bed, pet, leg, web, etc.

- ❖ Reads words with two consonants and vowels like 'ee', 'oo', 'll', 'sh', 'ch', 'ck' phonetically.

e.g. - 'ee': bee, tree, queen, peel, green etc.

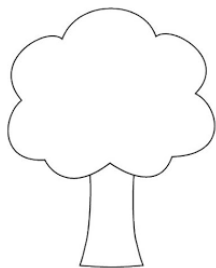
'oo': wool, room, broom, school, look etc.

'll': ball, well, doll, pill, shell, bull etc.

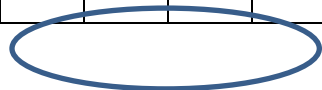
'sh': shop, shut, brush, sheep etc.

- ❖ Writes numbers 3, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20 in square sheets.

- ❖ Identifies and writes BEFORE, AFTER and MISSING numbers from 0-20.

- ❖ Arranges the given numbers from BIGGEST to SMALLEST and vice versa.

- ❖ Rolls the dice and tells Before/ After number of the outcome.

- ❖ चित्र देखकर वाक्य बनाना - (मौखिक क्रिया)



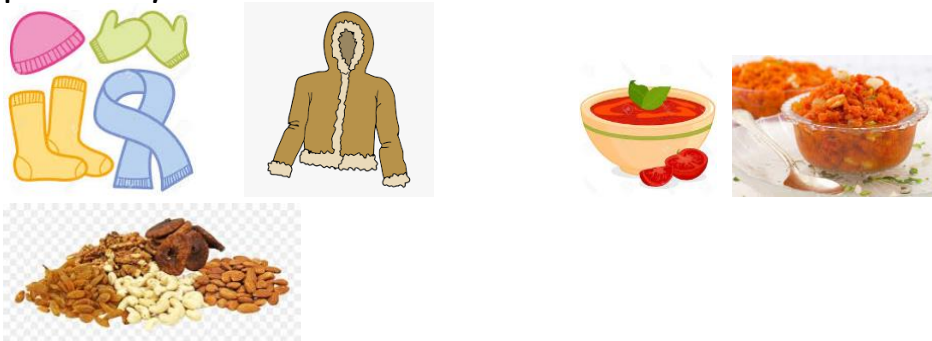
- फल चख कर रख।
