
# CURRIUCULUM INPUTS OF K.G. FOR THE MONTH OF APRIL AND MAY 2021

## **ENGLISH**-

Revisits the phonetic sounds of all the letters from a-z.



- Undertifies the beginning sound of a word-e.g.; fruit f, mug m, sat s etc.
- Tells words (at least four or five) beginning with a given letter e.g., "h" for hen, hut, horse, hammer etc.
- Arranges letters to spell his/her name using flash cards and draws a picture beginning with each letter.





The Reads 'at' and 'an' ending words fluently and learns to illustrate their meanings - bat, cat, rat, sat, hat, man, pan, ran, van etc.



# NUMBER CONCEPT-

Understands pre-number concepts like- big-small, full-empty, few-many, long-short, tall-short and thick-thin with the help of objects, pictures, etc.








Few-Many

- Traces all shapes on sand, rice or flour.






"Draws a figure with given shapes.

Undentifies taste of bitter gourd, sugar, salt, and lemon and categorizes them into bitter, sweet, salty and sour.




Undertifies different textures by touching the touch boards e.g., smooth, soft, hard, rough etc.
