
<u>Curriculum Inputs of K.G.</u> <u>for the months of July, August & September 2023</u>

e.g. - A man is in the car.




A big cat ran to a rat.

- ❖ Counts backwards from 5 to 1.
- Recites number rhymes with rhythmic movement. e.g.
 - 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 once I caught a fish alive...
 - One two buckle my shoe....

- Differentiates between a 'big family' and a 'small family' and places his/her family in one of the above categories.
- Enacts role play of different family members.



Discusses how he/she spends time with family.

My House

- * Expresses the importance of a house to living beings.
- Talks about how to use home furniture differently e.g.: a dining table can also be used as a study table.



Describes usage of commonly available technological tools like T.V., remotes, mobile phones and others available in house.


Our Neighbourhood and Helpers

- ❖ Talks to the people who help us in school like sweeper, gardener, guard etc. and identifies their tools.






- Enacts the role of any community helper and other children guess which role the child is playing.

Observes the changes in the environment- overcast sky, thunder, lightning, puddles of water, snails and earthworms wriggling etc.




* Talks about ones likes/dislikes of this season.

Classifies the different types of plants during nature walk.




* Recalls the names of a few shady trees around the house and in school and understands their importance e.g., Neem, Peepal, Jamun, Mango etc.

drawings.


Learns about different conditions may are necessary for a plant to grow. e.g., soil, sun, water and air.

Identifies the various fruits and vegetables and learns their English/ Hindi names. Classifies them according to their number of seeds, season, colour and taste.






Animal Life


