My Senses:

> Visual Sense -

- Recognises colours of different objects in his/her surroundings e.g. The leaves are green, The table is yellow, etc.
- Recites rhymes on colours e.g. Red colour red colour , My red balloon.
- How to take care of your eyes(sense organ)





Auditory sense-

- Identifies and distinguishes between familiar sounds in the environment and sounds of different objects- eg; chirping of birds, ringing of the school bell, clapping hands
- How to take care of ears (sense organ)



Sense of Touch -

- Feels various objects in the feel bag and names them.
- Feels various textures by touching things in the surroundings like bark of a tree, bricks etc

- Identifies one's gender- boy/girl.
- Identifies different parts of the body and their function.
- Introduces oneself through King/Queen game.

> Alphabet:

• Recognizes capital and small letters and their phonetic sounds Ss, Aa.



Matches letter cards with corresponding picture cards.



- Names and draws 4-5 objects beginning with these letters.
- Differentiates between capital and small letters.

- Recites alphabet rhymes with actions.




